This letter is in response to your request for document access received on March 26th, 2019 and by which you would like to obtain a copy of the event reports prepared in 2018 as well as January and February 2019 involving Sépaq's national parks.

Unfortunately, the event reports filled are strictly confidential. Indeed, those documents are addressed and intended to the exclusive use of the Legal Services Department at the Sépaq. That degree of confidentiality comes from the right to professional secrecy and non-disclosure of confidential information between the client, here the Sépaq, and its lawyers, as protected by section 9 of the Charter of human rights and freedoms (RLRQ, chapter C-12).

Considering that your request for document access has been processed in accordance with the provisions of the Act respecting access to documents held by public bodies and the protection of personal information protection, we would like to remind you that you may request a review of this decision to the *Commission d'accès à l'information*. The application must be made within thirty days of the date of this decision, in conformity with sections 135 and following of the Act respecting access to documents held by public bodies and the protection of personal information protection (RLRQ, chapter A-2.1). To this end, a notice of recourse is attached to this letter.
