	<b>Sentier des Pins</b> – Get around this pine plantation, don't forget to bring your camera.	2.5 km Easy
	<b>Sentier du Camping</b> – Follow this trail and explore our different campsites, maybe these will charm you.	1.9 km Easy
	<b>Sentier de la Plage</b> – Come walk in the fine sand and enjoy the sun at the same time.	1.4 km Easy
	<b>Sentier de la Falaise</b> – Skirts the cliff while offering a splendid view of lake Simon and its tributary, the Petite Nation river.	2.5 km Easy
	<b>Sentier du Cerf</b> – A small clearing offers you the possibility of seeing white-tailed deer.	1.1 km Easy
	<b>Sentier du Marais</b> – Come and take a break in the thuja forest. Be on the lookout for several species of birds and amphibians that take refuge in the swamp.	1.1 km Easy
	<b>Sentier de la Tortue</b> – Bring your lunch, picnic tables are waiting for you.	300 m Easy
	<b>Sentier de la Mésange</b> – This small trail is a designated spot for bird watching.	300 m Easy
	<b>Sentier du Tamia</b> – This trail will lead you to the splendid Lac de la Ferme, keep your eyes and ears open, maybe you will spot a little friend.	1.9 km Easy
	<b>Sentier du Poisson</b> – <b>Note!</b> Access limited to certain times of the year – Whitt its few climbs, this trail offers beautiful views of Lac de la Ferme.	3.5 km Easy

### Campsite Regulation

- The curfew is in effect from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- A campsite can accommodate up to 6 people (max. 4 adults for the traditional ready-to-camp).
- A campsite can accommodate up to 2 tents or 1 registered recreational equipment and 1 tent.
- The maximum speed allowed in camping areas is 10 km/h.
- One vehicle is allowed per camping spot.
- **Camping spots must be vacated by 2 p.m.**
