WELCOME TO DEER ISLAND

If Anticosti Island makes you dream, it is of course because of its spectacular landscapes, its crystalline rivers, and the waterfalls that provide the breath of life, along with the deer and the foxes that you meet there at the peak of day... But it is also because of the aura of mystery that emanates from the fossils, the caves, the wrecks, and the cemeteries that are scattered around the island. This singular past gives rise to many legends.

There is also history. First, that of Henri Menier, a rich French chocolate maker who left his name to the only village on Anticosti, Port-Menier, located on the west side of the island. This picturesque character acquired Anticosti in 1895 and the following year introduced white-tailed deer captured by a trapper from Cap-Saint-Ignace. Since then, the absence of predators and the great adaptability of these deer have led to a steady increase in their population.

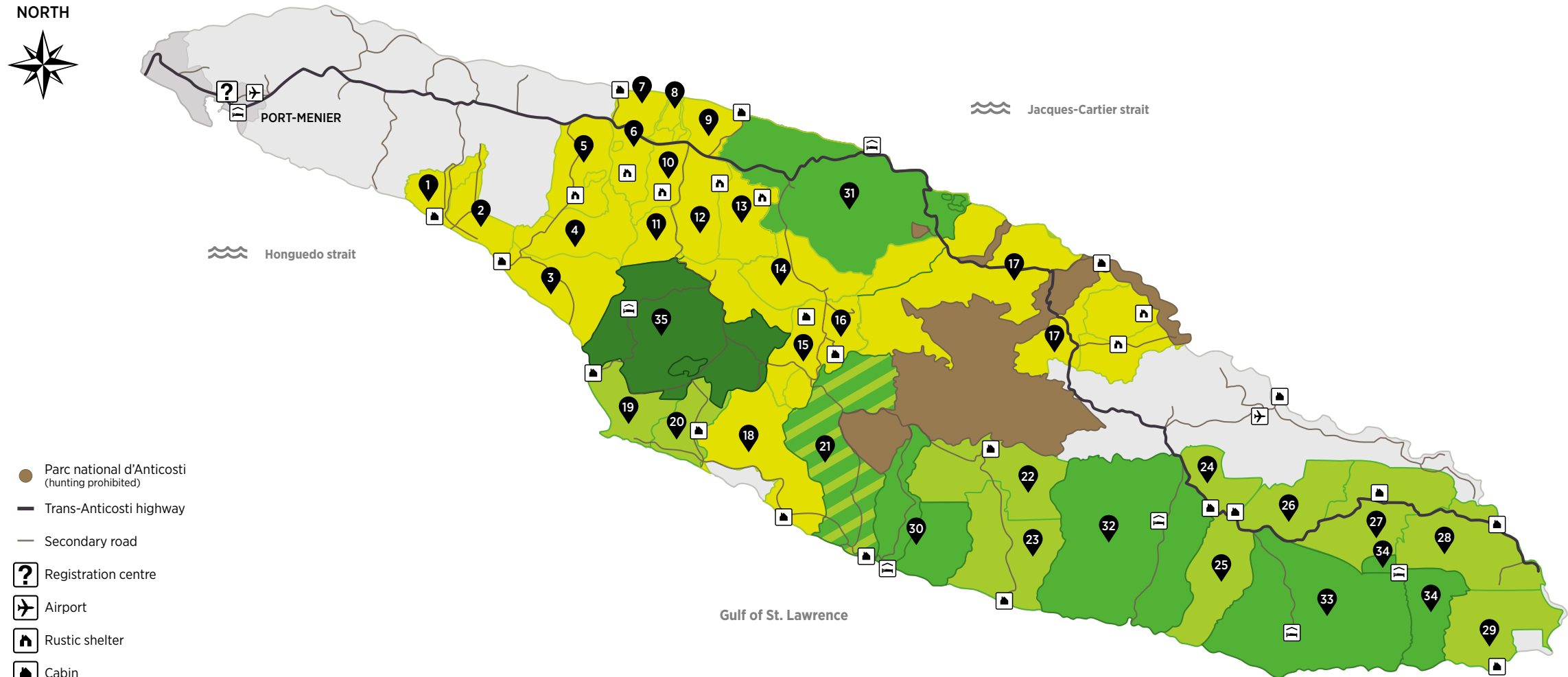
In 1967, the island passed into the hands of the Consolidated Bathurst forestry company. Then, in 1974, the Québec government acquired the island and proceeded to divide up the territory. Ten years later, the management of most of the territory was entrusted to Sépaq. Since then, the island's reputation has spread far beyond its borders...

HUNTING WITH EACH PASSING MONTH

SEPTEMBER

The days are still long, which leaves more time for hunting.

The deer feeds everywhere: marshes, peat bogs, and in mature forest stands where mushrooms abound.

At dusk there's good hunting along the paths and in the clearings.

OCTOBER

The weather is comfortable.

The deer is at its peak weight, and this is when the meat tastes best.

At the first frosts, hunting is good at the seaside where the roe deer feed on algae.

NOVEMBER

This is the rutting period, when the male is less shy and more active.

Rattling and calling techniques will do the trick.

The trails are easy to follow in the morning frost and sometimes in the loose snow, where you can walk about without making a sound.

DECEMBER

The chances of snow are higher.

The southward migration leads to a greater concentration of deer in the only part of the island still open to hunting.

This is the best time for hunting at the seaside.

View the map of your sector in hard copy or download it **before your trip** on a microSD card for Garmin GPS or with the Avenza Maps mobile application.

TRANSPORT BOXES AND PAPER

Available in all refrigerated game larder cabinets (walk-in coolers) for transporting your harvests.

GROUP HUNTING

All members of the group can continue to hunt as long as one of them still has a transport coupon attached to his or her licence.

PAIRING UP

If you are alone or missing a hunter in your group, you can pair up with other hunting enthusiasts in all guided packages.

RADIO TRANSMITTER AND PORTABLE RADIO

Available for hunters in guided groups to communicate with our team at all times. As radios have a limited range, it is wise to provide relay distances between hunters.

The former Lac Marc enclosure, covering an area of 12 km², has been dismantled and provides an abundant food source for deer.

The sector is also home to the magnificent Auberge McDonald. In addition to a superb view of the sea, the lodge offers accommodation and food services in incomparable comfort, and the spacious living rooms are perfect for relaxing after a day of hunting. The rooms have been completely refurbished to a high standard. There is also a refrigerated game larder cabinet (walk-in cooler) on site.

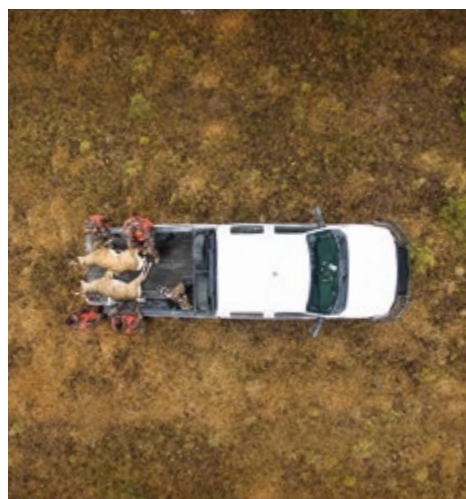
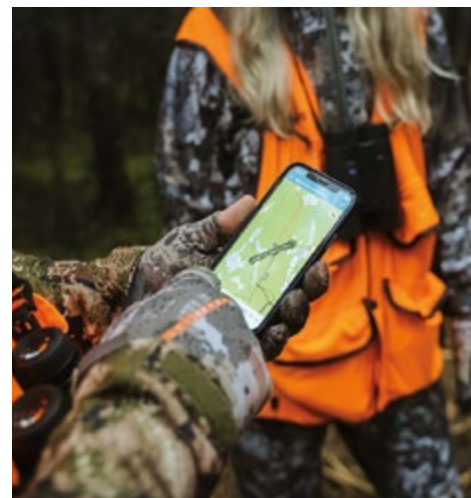
HOW ABOUT ADDING A DAY OF FISHING?

Take advantage of your holiday in Anticosti to go fishing. As day fishing on the island's lakes and rivers is a restricted activity and subject to certain conditions, bookings must be made on site by paying the access fee. Availability is sometimes limited and cannot be guaranteed. Watercraft and motor rentals are also available.

Reservation procedures for hunting

Payment for bookings: Payment should be made to the Customer Relations Centre by credit card or cheque. A deposit of 10% per hunter is required at the time of booking. A second payment (20%) is due 9 months before the start of the holiday. The balance is payable 90 days before the start of the holiday. Bookings made less than 90 days before the start of the holiday must be paid in full by the deadline specified at the time of booking. Any booking that does not meet the payment deadline or whose payment is not honoured by a financial institution will be automatically cancelled. Some administrative charges may be levied.

Spread out payments: When you book, spread the payment of your trip over several months, without interest. Monthly instalments are based on the number of months remaining before the start of your stay: an appealing and simple formula.

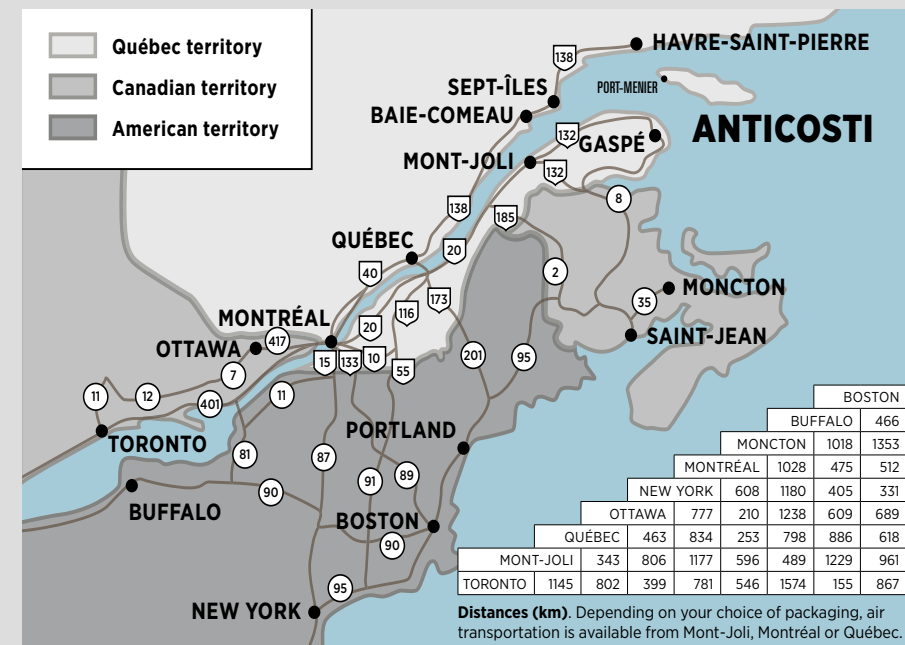
Cancellation fees: No refunds will be given less than 90 days before the start of the stay, but Sépaq Anticosti will accept a replacement at all times. The 10% deposit per hunter is not refundable.

Refunds: No refunds will be given to customers arriving late or leaving before the scheduled end of the stay for reasons beyond Sépaq Anticosti's control. Sépaq Anticosti strongly recommends that you take out cancellation insurance.

Flight delay or cancellation: Weather conditions may limit aircraft access to Anticosti Island.
